It is designed to support teachers with cross-curricular learning and includes a written pack and accompanying digital resources for both practical and classroom use.

At the heart of the resource is a six-week scheme of work designed for Key Stage Two pupils. Extension and simplification suggestions make it suitable for use from Years 3-6. The primarySTEPS resource is not for sale and is therefore only available to those attending a Teachers' Day. No previous experience of ballet is required.
