

PERIPATETIC GUITAR TEACHER

OVERALL PURPOSE OF THE POST

To teach Guitar at The Royal Ballet School, White Lodge.

SUMMARY OF THE ROLE

Guitar teaching to approximately 5 students. This reflects the current situation and is, of course, subject to change. The days of the White Lodge lessons can be flexible each week, upon discussion with the Lead Teacher of Music. Teaching hours at White Lodge are between 8.30am and 4.00pm.

CONTRACT TERMS

Rate of Pay	£550 per student per academic year for White Lodge students (billed each half term).
Hours	White Lodge students have 27 lessons of 40 minutes over the academic year.

MAIN DUTIES

This list should be seen as illustrative rather than prescriptive

- Teach one-to-one lessons in the desired discipline(s) at White Lodge, ensuring that 27 lessons (per discipline) of 40 minutes are carried out per academic year.
- Prepare students for ABRSM examinations / similar as required, including preparing them for sight-reading and aural tests.
- Draw up a weekly timetable of lessons, following procedures according to the detailed workings of the Ballet and Academic schedules at White Lodge. As the Royal Ballet School is primarily a ballet-training school for young, aspiring dancers, a degree of flexibility will be required with timetabling lessons at specific points in the academic year.
- To explore the option of running a small ensemble, depending on the scope of instrumentalists available in any academic year (this would be remunerated separately).
- Perform at musical events if required by the Lead Teacher of Music (these will be remunerated separately).

PERSON SPECIFIATION

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

- Solid experience of peripatetic teaching to secondary school students in your specific discipline
- Training to at least degree level or equivalent in Guitar
- Flexibility to work around the complexities of the weekly timetables of The Royal Ballet School
- Competent administrative skills regarding weekly timetabling of lessons, keeping registers and communicating with staff and parents where necessary
- An ability and willingness to maintain discipline at a high standard
- Able to maintain appropriate relationships with staff and students
- A confident and open approach with excellent interpersonal skills
- Understanding of the aims and ethos of the school

DESIRABLE CRITERIA

- The ability to teach the Drums would be a useful addition
- Professional performance experience
- Willingness to enter more widely into events within the Music Department should the need arise
- Experience of teaching virtually
